5/24/18 (Dr. Felix Savoie)	<p>I have had a couple like this, unfortunately; I used some #5 ethibond sutures and mersiline tape via drill holes in humeral shaft to lift humerus up to acromion, and also suture to glenoid and close any available tissue around the end of the humerus- immobilize in "gunslinger brace" for 6 weeks. Decent improvement in pain - the pain was mainly from plexus traction- and did not alter function- in fact some improvement.</p> <p>I have also tried to arthrodesis but not very successfully: screws through shaft into glenoid and long plate- was eventually an abysmal failure.</p> <p>Buddy</p> <p>Felix H Savoie M.D.</p>
